- (a) whether any action plan has been prepared by the National Highways Authority of India on AIDS awareness among the truck drivers frequenting the National Highways;

(a) to (d) National Highways Authority of India (NHAI) has been implementing Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV) /AIDS awareness programme under Lucknow-Muzaffarpur National Highway Project (LMNHP) on NH-28. The truck drivers are one of the stakeholders of this ongoing programme. This programme is being funded from loan component of LMNHP World Bank Loan No. 4764-IN. For implementation of this programme NHAI has appointed four Non- governmental Organisations (NGOs) viz, M/s Lokarpit; M/s Gramin Mahila Kalyan Sansthan; M/s Advantage India and M/s Asia Society for Entrepreneurship & Development. NHAI is also seeking assistance from National Aids Control Organisation (NACO) to extend such programme on other stretches under NHDP.
