(e) whether requests have been received for allocation of funds for widening and upgradation of Lalsot Valley on the said road; and

(f) if so, the details thereof and the reaction of the Government thereto?

A provision of Rs. 19.00 crore has been made in the Annual Plan 2009-10 for improvement and development of NH-11A Extension, which includes Lalsot also. The estimates have been received from the State Government and will be sanctioned during the year 2009-10 subject to availability of funds and the proposals meeting the norms.
