WIND POWER PLANTS BY ONGC

**Will the Minister of PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether Oil and Natural Gas Corporation (ONGC) proposes to set up wind power plants in various parts of the country including Tamil Nadu;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the details of the proposed sites identified for the purpose and the expenditure likely to be incurred in setting up of such units; and
- (d) the estimated quantum of the wind power likely to be generated from each of such units?

**Answer**

MINISTER OF THE STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PETROLEUM & NATURAL GAS (SHRI JITIN PRASADA)

(a) to (d): ONGC proposes to set up 102 Mega Watt (MW) capacity Wind Power Project in Rajasthan at an estimated cost of 650 crores; Site would be known based on the successful bid in a competitive bidding process. The average annual generation would be in the range of 200-210 million units ~1 Unit = 1 Kilo Watt hours (KLH).
