(a) the total expenditure on imported crude oil and indigenously produced crude oil;

(b) whether the Government is working on any action plan to increase the production of crude oil by the Government undertakings and private sector in the coming five years;and

(c) if so, the details thereof?

MINISTER OF THE STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PETROLEUM & NATURAL GAS (SHRI JITIN PRASADA)

(a) The total value of imported crude oil during 2009-10 was Rs.3,75,378 crores (US \$ 79,552 million). Information in respect of indigenously produced crude oil is readily not available and is being collected.

(b) & (c) Several measures have been taken to accelerate hydrocarbon exploration and production activities to meet our maximum requirement from indigenous sources, which include the following:

i. Carving out more and more areas of exploration for offer under various rounds of New Exploration Licensing Policy (NELP)/Coal Bed Methane (CBM) Policy.

ii. Application of Enhanced Oil Recovery (EOR)/Improved Oil Recovery (IOR) techniques for increasing recovery factor from existing fields.

iii. Acquisition of exploration acreages and producing properties overseas to bring in equity oil.

iv. Arresting decline from ageing fields.

v. Substitution of oil through use of non-conventional sources of energy such as bio-diesel, ethanol etc. Extraction of Gas from Gas Hydrates under National Gas Hydrates Programmes (NGHP) by evolving suitable production technology.
