Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to convert several stretches of National Highway-87 into four lane;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, stretch-wise;
- (c) whether widening of the Bridge/construction of a new bridge on the river Bhakhra at Bilaspur is also proposed under this project; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

Answer

- (a)&(b): Yes, Sir. Four laning of Rampur-Kathgodam section from km.0.00 to km.87.100 of NH-87 is proposed under NHDP Phase-III.
- (c)&(d): Yes, Sir. Bilaspur bypass from km.26.100 to km.33.100 of NH-87 has been proposed for 4-laning under NHDP Phase-III which includes construction of a new four lane bridge at km .29.750. The total length of proposed bridge is 105 metre.
