(a) to (d). The project is still in a conceptual stage and requires a detailed feasibility study to establish its techno-commercial viability. The second tripartite meeting between Turkey-Israel-India was held in July 2009 in Israel to discuss conceptual features of the project. There has been no further development on the project proposal since then.
