Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether several stretches of the National Highways in Tamil Nadu are in a dilapidated State including NH-82;
- (b) if so, the details thereof including names of such stretches in the State NH-wise; and
- (c) the details of the steps taken and funds allocated for the repair and maintenance of the National Highways in Tamil Nadu including their present status, NH-wise?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS (SHRI R. P. N. SINGH)

- (a) The National Highways passing through the State of Tamil Nadu are not in dilapidated state and are being maintained in traffic worthy condition within the available resources. The National Highway No. 82 does not pass through the State of Tamil Nadu.
- (b) Does not arise.
- (c) Allocation of funds for repair and maintenance of National Highways are made State- wise not NH-wise. Amount allocated for the year 2009-10 under Maintenance & Repair to Tamil Nadu state is Rs.23.75 crore.
