MAINTENANCE OF NATIONAL HIGHWAYS IN U.P.

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether several stretches of the National Highways in Uttar Pradesh are in a dilapidated State;
- (b) if so, the details thereof including names of such stretches in the said State, NH-wise; and
- (c) the details of the steps taken and funds allocated for the repair and maintenance of the National Highways in Uttar Pradesh including their present status, NH-wise?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS (SHRI R. P. N. SINGH)

(a) to (c) No, Sir. All National Highways in the State of Uttar Pradesh are presently being maintained in traffic worthy condition keeping in view the traffic, inter-se-priority and availability of funds. Funds are allocated to the State as a whole and not NH-wise. During last four years and current year, Rs.292.75 crore have been allocated to the State of Uttar Pradesh for Maintenance & Repair of National Highways.
