- (d) if so, the details thereof?

- (a): Export Oriented firms set up in Government run Software Technology Parks are enjoying the tax benefits under Section 10 A of the Income Tax Act, 1961. These benefits are applicable upto 31-03-2011.
- (b): No, Sir.
- (c) & (d): The Government of India had recently set up a Task Force to suggest measures to stimulate the growth of IT-ITES and Electronics Hardware Manufacturing Industry in the country in the backdrop of significant challenges faced by the IT industry owing to the global recession. The Government has constituted a Committee of Secretaries (COS) for facilitating examination of the recommendations made by the Task Force.
