- (b) if not, whether the Government proposes to make available more medicines for Jan Aushadhi outlets especially from the small and medium sector units in the country;
- (c) if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) the other steps being taken by the Government to enlarge the basket of medicines supplied to Jan Aushadhi outlets?

(a) to (d) The basket of medicines presently being supplied through Jan Aushadhi Stores cover a wide range of Therapeutic Categories such as Analgesic Anti-inflammatory, Antimicrobial, Anti-infective (Topicals), Vitamins, Cardiovascular drugs etc. The basket of Jan Aushadhi medicines is being actively enlarged from the current list of about 230 medicines to 350 medicines. It is considered nearly adequate to take care of the ailments generally suffered by the public. However, in order to meet the other emergency medicines, surgical items etc. as may be required for the patients, stores were authorized to procure and supply such items through a committee headed by Civil Surgeon. Sourcing of items from the private manufacturers of medicines and surgical items etc. to enlarge the basket of supply to the stores including from SMEs will also be explored as may be considered necessary.
