- (a) & (b) During the last 5 years (2005-2010) 8276 matters were registered with National Commission for Minority Educational Institutions (NCMEI), out of which 7284 have been disposed of and number of pending matters is only 992. State-wise information is not available.
- (c) The number of sittings as well as the number of cases heard by the Commission at each sitting have increased. The NCMEIAct, 2005 is being amended to provide for inter-alia, one additional Member.
- (d) Information on significant orders passed by the NCMEI are included in the Annual Reports of the NCMEI, which are laid before the Parliament and are also available on the website (www.ncmei.gov.in) of the NCMEI.
