## **Answer**

(a) and (b): National Association of Software and Services Companies (NASSCOM) and National Manufacturing Competitiveness Council (NMCC) have brought out a report `A Roadrnap of ICT adoption in the Indian Manufacturing Sector`. The objective of this report is to identify the current stage ICT adoption in the manufacturing sector, especially in the Micro, Small and Medium-sized Enterprises [MSME] and the factors hindering the adoption of ICT therein. The `roadmap` identifies shared responsibilities between the government, technology companies, industry association, academia, and manufacturing firms for enhancing ICT adoption.
