- (a) whether there are reports that harmful injections are being given to milch animals to increase the quantity of milk;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, State-wise; and
- (c) the measures taken by the Government to check the use of such injections?

Answer

(a) to (c): No, Madam. An injection named oxytocin is used by the farmers for letting down of milk. Government has advised the State Animal Husbandry Departments to educate the farmers in the States/UTs about the appropriate use of the Oxytocin and for not using this product without the prescription of registered veterinary practitioners.
