(a) & (b): The Centrally Sponsored Scheme on Development of Inland Fisheries & Aquaculture has a component on Development of Brackishwater Aquaculture under which subsidy is provided to small shrimp farmers having land holding of 2 ha or less for construction of ponds. In addition, the National Fisheries Development Board (N FDB) is operating schemes to promote coastal aquaculture and mariculture, which includes seed production and culture of shrimp and brakishwater fin fishes.
