(c-d) As compared to a production of 126 million MTs of vegetables in India during 2007-08, export is only 1.72 million MTs which is 1.36% of total production. Similarly, in fruits, against a production of 65.3 million tonnes, export of 2 million tonnes reflects a share of 3.06%. The low share in exports vis- \tilde{A} -vis production is because of several factors which include high domestic consumption, fragmented food supply chain, small land holdings, lack of appropriate infrastructure, high cost of logistics, difficulties in meeting global standards, high international transportation costs, etc.
