In respect of scholarship schemes, request for extension of the last date of submission made in the interest of students by the State Governments/UT Administrations have been entertained. As regards Free Coaching & Allied Scheme, only those proposal which are complete in all respect have been considered for approval. The State Governments/UT Administrations are requested regularly to send proposals in time.
