(a) to (b) As per the Hon'ble Supreme Court's Order dated 27.7.2010, a Task Force headed by Director General, National Informatics Centre has been set up on 9.8.2010. The Task Force has submitted its report for Computerization of the Public Distribution System.

Government of India has taken up the scheme of computerization of Targeted Public Distribution System (TPDS) operations to improve the efficiency and effectiveness of the TPDS on a pilot basis in three districts each of Andhra Prdesh, Assam, Chhattisgarh and Delhi and piloting of food grain bag tracking in one district in Chhattisgarh.

A pilot scheme on Smart Card based delivery of essential commodities has been approved for Chandigarh UT and Haryana. Under the scheme, existing ration cards are to be replaced by Smart Cards.
