GAUGE CONVERSION UNDER NORTH-EASTERN RAILWAY

**Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether gauge conversion work is going on in Gonda under North-Eastern Railway;
- (b) if so, the details thereof alongwith fund allocated for the same; and
- (c) the time by which the said work is likely to be completed?

(a) to (c): Yes, Madam. Gonda-Gorakhpur including Anandnagar-Nautanwa (260 km) and Gonda-Bahraich (60 km) are the ongoing gauge conversion projects in Gonda under North-Eastern Railway. Both the projects are in progress. An outlay of Rs. 30 crore and 10 crore respectively have<sup>1</sup> been provided for these projects for the year 2010-11. The projects will be completed in the coming years as per availability of resources.
