- (b) Under the banner of Chemicals and Allied Products Export Promotion Council (CAPEXIL) around ten companies participated in the International Stone fair at Moscow from 23rd to 26th June, 2009. Apart from this, six more Indian companies participated on their own. The Russian stone market is growing due to their growth in the construction industry. Due to large number of companies participating in the fair, there was a better impact. A large numbers of potential visitors made serious inquiries for supply of stone products.
- (c) All incentives under the Foreign Trade Promotion Schemes are available to the Indian natural stone exporters.
