- (a) to (c) The Ministry has, so far, received proposals for declaration of various State Roads as National Highways (NHs) from various State Governments and Union Territories for a total length of about 59,000 km. The Empowered Group of Ministers (EGoM) in its meeting held on 17.3.2010, inter-alia, approved "In-Principle", declaration of about 10,000 km of State Roads as new National Highways (NHs). The principles/criteria for identification of stretches will be finalized after discussion with the Planning Commission. The State-wise and length-wise details of these 10,000 km of State roads have not yet been identified.
