- (a) whether the Terminal (T3) of Indira Gandhi International Airport is a World Class Terminal;
- (b) if so, the total cost of its construction;
- (c) whether there is any proposal to build such terminals in other parts of the country; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

(a) & (b): Yes, Madam. The estimated cost of Terminal 3 of Indira Gandhi International Airport, New Delhi is Rs.9630.10 crores.

(c)&(d): Airports Authority of India has undertaken the development and modernisation of terminal buildings at Kolkata, Chennai, Lucknow, Ranchi, Bhopal, Indore, Coimbatore, Goa and Raipur airports. Besides, M/s Mumbai International Airport (P) Ltd. has also taken up development of CSI Airport, Mumbai. Intergrated terminals have also been constructed at Varanashi, Srinagar, Aurangabad, Nagpur, Pune, Madurai, Mangalore, Trichy and Vizag.
