## Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Medical Council of India (MCI) has recommended a common entrance examination for admission to medical colleges and also a common exit examination for MBBS pass-outs in the country;

(b) if so, the details thereof alongwith the reasons therefor;

(c) the follow up action taken by the Government thereon;

(d) whether there has been opposition from the State Governments against such move; and

(e) if so, the details thereof?

## Answer

THE MINISTER OF HEALTH & FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI GHULAM NABI AZAD)

(a) & (b): This Ministry received a proposal from Medical Council of India (MCI) for conducting single entrance exam for admissions in undergraduate and postgraduate medical courses in India.

(c): The Ministry has directed MCI to re-examine the proposal in the light of apprehensions expressed by some States.

(d) & (e): Yes. Some State Governments have opposed the proposal.
