THE MINISTER OF HEALTH & FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI GHULAM NABI AZAD)

(a) to (f): Under National Rural Health Mission [NRHM], funds are provided to State/UTs to strengthen their health infrastructure at all levels including for district hospitals and maternity hospitals in rural areas. The respective State/UT Governments incorporate their requirement for improving the infrastructure for better service delivery in their annual Programme Implementation Plans[PIPs]. The same is examined in this Ministry and funds are released to State/UT Governments as per the approval accorded to the PIP for actual implementation.
