(d) Currently, CBM is being commercially produced @ 1, 00,000 m3/day from the Ranganj (South) block in West Bengal operated by Great Eastern Energy Corporation Limited (GEECL).

(e) In order to boost production of CBM in the country, a total of 33 CBM blocks have been awarded so far. The estimated CBM production in the country is about 7 Million Standard Cubic Meter Per Day (MMSCMD) by the year 2014.
