## **Answer**

## MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SHRI PRADEEP JAIN 'ADITYA')

- (a) & (b): Yes, Sir. The Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY) has been launched to provide all-weather connectivity to the eligible unconnected rural habitations with population of 500 persons and above in plain areas and 250 persons and above in hill States, tribal (Schedule-V) areas, desert areas (as identified in the Desert Development Programme) and Left Wing Extremism affected districts as identified by the Ministry of Home Affairs.
- (c) & (d): More than 50% of habitations eligible for taking up under PMGSY have been connected for all States expect Arunachal Pradesh, Bihar, Goa, Himachal Pradesh, Jammu & Kashmir, Jharkhand, Manipur, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Orissa, Sikkim and Uttrakhand.
