- (a) to (c): The Government of India provides one time ex-gratia relief of Rupees One Lakh under the scheme `Journalists Welfare Fund` to accredited journalists who suffer permanent disability rendering them incapable of discharging their duties due to unnatural causes and in the course of their duty. The Scheme is available at www.mib.nic.in.
- (d) Apart from above, Press Information Bureau (PIB) accredited journalists are also provided with facilities like Government Accommodation; benefits of Central Government Health Scheme (CGHS); concession in Rail fare as well as exemption in customs duty for import of professional equipments.
