STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) to (d) OF UNSTARRED QUESTION NO. 1429 BY SHRI NARAYANSINGH AMLABE TO BE ANSWERED IN LOK SABHA ON 18.11.2010 REGARDING MODERNISATION OF RAILWAY STATIONS IN MADHYA PRADESH.

(a): The scheme of Adarsh station is currently in vogue for upgradation of railway stations. Under this scheme, 3 (three) stations viz. Ashok Nagar, Chhindwara and Saugor in the year 2009-10 and 2 (two) railway stations viz. Ghatara and Ratlam in the current year from the State of Madhya Pradesh have been identified.

(b) to (d): Funds are sanctioned Railway-wise. Madhya Pradesh falls on 7 (seven) Zonal Railways. Improvement/upgradation works are done under Plan Head 'Passenger Amenities' for concerned Zonal Railways for which fund allocation in the year 2010-11 is as under:
