- (a) & (b): In order to the promote and protect the handloom sector which includes, Self Help Groups/Handloom Weavers Cooperative Societies/Corporations/Associations etc. and the handloom weavers in the country, the Government of India is implementing the following developmental/welfare schemes during the XIth Five Year Plan:
- i. Integrated Handlooms Development Scheme (IHDS)
- ii. Handloom Weavers' Comprehensive Welfare Scheme (HWCWS)-comprises of two components:
- (a) Health Insurance Scheme
- (b) Mahatma Gandhi Bunkar Bima Yojana
- iii. Marketing and Export Promotion Scheme (MEPS)
- iv. Mill Gate Price Scheme (MGPS)
- v. Diversified Handloom Development Scheme(DHDS)
