(a) to (c): For the safety and security of tourists, responsibility for which rests with the State Governments/Union Territories, Ministry of Tourism has formulated guidelines for formation of Tourist Security Organization(s), which have been forwarded to the State Governments & Union Territory Administrations. These guidelines require the State Governments/Union Territory Administrations to obtain a three or four digit helpline telephone number from the concerned telephone departments for the convenience of tourists which should be managed by the Tourist Security Organization. Ministry of Tourism pursues with the States that with helpline based appropriate technological solutions, they widen the scope to provide other helpful information to tourists.
