## THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF POWER(SHRI BHARATSINH SOLANKI)

(a) to (c): Alaknanda Hydro Electric Project (3x100 MW) is being developed by M/s GMR Energy Limited in Uttarakhand. The project was accorded concurrence by Central Electricity Authority (CEA) on 8th August, 2008. Civil contracts are in advance stage of award. Electro-Mechanical bids are under evaluation, and the process for achieving financial closure is underway. However, forest clearance to the project has so far not been accorded by Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India and construction on major components like dam, etc. has not yet started.
