(a) to (c): Government is improving relations with other countries by promoting cultural exchanges and fostering and strengthening cultural relations between India and other countries. ICCR as an autonomous cultural organization under Ministry of External Affairs is the pre-eminent institution of cultural diplomacy and main sponsor of cultural exchanges. An important component to promote cultural exchanges is organizing of Festival of India in other countries. These Festivals are comprehensive and cover all aspects of Indian Culture. They consist of variety of many performances of Indian classical, contemporary, tribal and folk art, music and dance forms. They cover all aspects of India's rich cultural heritage.
