- (a) & (b): India's policy vis a vis Myanmar is independent of third country's involvement in Myanmar. India's policy towards Myanmar is one of constructive engagement based on enhanced bilateral and developmental cooperation. Regular high level exchange of visits have been taking place. Further, several institutional mechanisms have been set up for facilitating regular dialogue on issues of bilateral interest.
- (c): India has been implementing various projects in Myanmar, including over the last one year, in the areas of road infrastructure, railways, capacity building, connectivity, vocational training, IT, agriculture, telecommunication, culture etc.
