PROPOSAL FOR SETTING UP OF MEDICAL COLLEGES

Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Union Government has received proposals from some States including Chhattisgarh, Gujarat and Tamil Nadu for the setting up of medical colleges;
- (b) if so, the details of such proposals received during the last three years and the current year, State/UT-wise;
- (c) the present status of the said proposals;
- (d) whether the Government has rejected a number of proposals; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof alongwith the reasons therefor, proposal-wise and State/UT-wise?

Answer

(a) to (e) A total of 130 proposals for establishing of new medical colleges in various States/UTs were received during the last three years out of which 61 were returned to the applicant on account of deficient/incomplete documents. For the current session 2011-12, the last date for receiving the proposal is 30.11.2010. State-wise status of the proposals is Annexed.
