THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF WATER RESOURCES (SHRI VINCENT H. PALA)

(a): At present, there is no proposal for formulation of specific scheme for "improvement, renovation, restoration of reservoirs rendered useless and review the repair works of reservoirs and dams". However, Government of India provides financial assistance to States for Extension, Renovation and Modernization of major/medium irrigation projects under "Accelerated Irrigation Benefits Programme". Assistance is also provided to States under the scheme of "Repair, Renovation and Restoration of Water Bodies".
