- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether there is evidence of fake currency being used to fund terrorism and organised crimes in the country; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and the steps taken to seek international cooperation to tackle the problem of fake currency in the country?

STATEMENT IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (d) OF LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION No. 455 FOR 04.08.2009 REGARDING 'SOURCE OF FAKE CURRENCY'.

- (a) to (c): Available inputs indicate that high quality Fake Indian Currency Notes (FICNs) are printed in a neighbouring country and pushed into India through neighbouring countries. Such inputs also indicate that Lashkar-e-Taiba (LeT) activists, organized criminal networks and syndicates are reportedly involved in infusion and circulation of FICN in the country.
- (d): India's concerns on the printing and circulation of Fake Indian Currency Notes are raised in the bilateral mechanisms established to address our security concerns.
