(a) to (d): Government has constituted a Task Force chaired by Shri N. Rangachari, former Chairman, CBDT and IRDA for undertaking a study to evolve a mechanism to protect the growers of tea, coffee, rubber and spices from the adverse effects of price volatility in the Plantation Sector. Government has established a Price Stabilization Fund Trust (PSFT) with the objective of safeguarding the intrest of growers of tea, coffee, rubber & tobacco and provide financial relief when prices fall below a specified level without resorting to procurment operations by Government Agencies. The prices, which are governed by market forces, are currently favourable to the growers.
