## Will the Minister of COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY be pleased to state:

- (a) whether increase in visa fee is estimated to put an additional burden of \$ 200 million annually on Indian IT firms;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the steps being taken to correct the situation in future?

## **Answer**

(a) to (c) The US Congress has approved a \$ 600 million emergency funding package to improve security along the US-Mexico border on August JL2, 2010 and the bill S-3271 has been signed into law [HR 6080] on August 13, 2010. The law has increased the fee for an H-1B and L-I visa by \$2000 and \$2250 respectively for companies that employ 50 or more employees in the United States if more than 50% of the companies` employees are on H-1B or L-I visa, till September 30, 2014. Trade bodies and chambers of commerce of the IT-BPO industries in India have expressed concerns about the financial impact of the law. India`s concerns on the issue have been taken up with the US side in the India US Trade Policy Forum and other bilateral engagements.
