Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government has a clear policy for maintenance of existing roads during construction phase of four laning/six laning by National Highway Authority of India;

(b) if so, the salient features of the said policy;

(c) whether NHAI is not in a position to maintain and develop the Jaipur-Delhi Road (NH-8) and other NH roads to prescribed standard; and

(d) if so, the details thereof and the steps taken by the Government in this regard?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS (SHRI R.P.N. SINGH)

(a) & (b): Yes, Sir. Wherever 4/6 laning works under NHDP are under implementation, to keep the existing roads in traffic worthy condition, the maintenance of existing roads are carried out by the Contractor/Concessionaire as part of their obligations under contract/ concession agreement.

(c) & (d):L No, Sir. Presently Gurgaon-Jaipur Road is being maintained by the Concessionaire as per provisions of Concession Agreement in traffic worthy condition. Directions are given to the concessionaires/contractors from time to time to maintain roads in traffic worthy condition.
