However, Indian Rare Earths Ltd., a public sector undertaking, has signed an agreement with Toyota Tsusho Corporation, Japan dated 04.12.2009 for the sale of 6000 MT/annum of rare earth chloride from its Monozite Processing plant at OSCOM, Orissa, which is expected to commence production by the end of 2011.
