(c) the total number of remote villages identified for the purpose in the country, State-wise;

(d) whether the Government has signed any agreement / Memorandum of Understanding with foreign countries / companies in this regard;

(e) if so, the details thereof; and

(f) the time by which all the remote villages / hamlets in the country are likely to be electrified?

(a),(b)&(c): The Ministry is implementing Remote Village Electrification Programme for providing financial support for lighting / basic electrification in those remote unelectrified census villages and unelectrified hamlets of electrified census villages where grid extension is not found feasible by the State Governments and hence are not covered under the Rajiv Gandhi Gramin Vidyutikaran Yojna. A target for coverage of 10000 such villages and hamlets has been set for the Remote Village Electrification Programme for 11th Plan Period at a total estimated outlay of Rs. 600 crores. A total number of 8874 remote villages / hamlets have so far been shortlisted by the concerned state governments which have also been endorsed by the Rural Electrification Programme. Statewise details are given in Table-I.

(d)&(e): No Memorandum of Understanding / Agreement have been signed in this regard.

(f): State Implementing Agencies have been advised to submit proposals for eligible villages and hamlets as soon as possible for financial support by this Ministry.
