(b) if so, the details thereof?

(a) & (b): It is too early to provide production estimates of wheat, for which sowing has just commenced for the current year. The prospects for Rabi have been reviewed by the Department at various levels with the wheat growing States. The agro-climatic conditions so far continue to be favourable for Rabi season. Adequate water is stored in reservoirs across the country. Late season rains have also helped in keeping soil moisture level congenial for rainfed wheat. Due to these climatic factors and active promotion of crop development programmes like National Food Security Mission (NFSM), Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana (RKVY) and Macro-Management of Agriculture (MMA), it is expected that the production of wheat could be better than the best achieved last year.
