- (a): India and USA signed a Memorandum of Understanding in March, 2010 for cooperation in Agriculture and Food Security. Under the MoU, the first 'India-USA Agriculture Dialogue' was held on 13-14 September, 2010 in New Delhi, which was co-chaired by Foreign Secretary and Under Secretary for Energy, Agriculture and Economic Affairs, US State Department. The Agriculture dialogue will provide a framework for renewing bilateral cooperation in three broad areas mainly strategic cooperation in agriculture and food security; agricultural extension services, farm to market linkages and food processing; and weather and crop forecasting.
- (b): During the period 2007-10, total Foreign Direct Investment (FDI) inflows from USA in agricultural services were US \$ 3.1 Million.
