(b): The aggregate application of N,P & K nutrients in the country has been improving in the recent years, which is in the ratio of 4.3:2.0:1.0 (2009-10) as against the preferred ratio of 4:2:1. A State-wise statement of NPK ratio during last 5 years is enclosed at annexure.
