- (d) if so, the details thereof?

- (a) & (b): Studies carried out by ICAR at different locations including Himachal Pradesh indicated that non-judicious and imbalanced use of inorganic fertilizers (NPK) over year may result in deterioration of soil fertility/nutrient deficiencies. The Government is therefore, promoting soil test-based balanced and judicious use of chemical fertilizers, bio-fertilizers and organic manures to maintain soil health and its productivity.
- (c) & (d): Yes, Madam. Quality of organic fertilizers is being regulated through Fertilizer Control Order, 1985.
