- (a) whether it has been reported that a large number of schools run by the Municipal Corporation of Delhi (MCD) are devoid of furniture like table and chairs for the students; and
- (b) if so, the reasons therefor and the corrective measures being taken for ensuring proper seating arrangement in such schools?

(a) & (b): Out of approximately 9.50 lakh students studying in the primary schools run by the Municipal Corporation of Delhi, approximately 8 lakh students are using the dual desk and the remaining students have been provided durries or jute patties to sit on. Improvement in facilities provided to the students is a continuous process. In this regard, the Municipal Corporation of Delhi has taken steps for purchase of 70,000 dual desks.
