**Will the Minister of PERSONNEL,PUBLIC GRIEVANCES AND PENSIONS be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether the Central Vigilance Commission (CVC) has worked out an action plan to check corruption;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the CVC proposes for stringent steps in this regard; and
- (d) if so, the time frame proposed within which the action plan would be implemented?

**Answer**

(a) to (c) : In order to promote good governance in the country, the Central Vigilance Commission has formulated a draft "National Anti Corruption Strategy" (NACS), as a guiding policy document. The proposed Strategy aims at systematic and conscious reshaping of the country's national integrity system. The draft Strategy recommends a set of action to be taken by the Government and a set of action by the political entities, judiciary, media, citizens, private sector and civil society organizations.

(d) : This is an ongoing process. The Commission reviews the progress of implementation of its recommendations on annual basis.
