(a) whether the number of Group `D` and `C` categories of employees in Central Government offices are declining over the years;

(b) if so, the number of Group `D` and `C` categories of employees in the year 1990 and the number thereof on 31 October, 2010;

(c) the reasons for such a decline in Group `D` and `C` employees; and

(d) the steps taken by the Government in this regard?

(a) to (d) : As per the information available, the estimated number of Group 'C' and 'D' Employees in the Central Government in the year 1990 and 2009 is as follows:

31.03.1990 17,74,005 16,39,626 01.03.2009 28,68,608#

After the implementation of the 6th Central Pay Commission, Group 'D' employees have been categorized as Group 'C'.
