- (a) the number of proposals for environmental development works received from in various States, State-wise;
- (b) the number of proposals approved by his Ministry during the last two years, State-wise;
- (c) the details of the centrally sponsored schemes being implemented by his Ministry in various States of the country, State-wise;
- (d) the details of the funds spent and works undertaken under these schemes during the last three years and the current year;
- (e) whether misuse of funds in implementation of these schemes has been reported; and
- (f) if so, the details thereof and the action taken by the Government in this regard?

(a) and (b) : The Ministry of Environment & Forests is implementing a number of Schemes, both central sector and centrally sponsored, for protection, conservation and development of the environment, based on its approved 11th Five Year Plan 2007-12. The schemes are of ongoing nature during the course of a Five Year Plan. Given their guidelines, funds are released to States under these schemes depending upon their past performance, current requirements and overall availability of funds under a scheme.

(c) and (d) :The details of Centrally Sponsored Schemes being implemented by the Ministry along with releases made to States, scheme-wise and State-wise, during the three years and the current year so far are given in the Annexure.
