(b) if so, the details thereof?

(a) and (b): Under the revised Central Sector Scheme (CSS) titled "Creation of Management Structure for Hazardous Substances" for setting up of Treatment, Storage and Disposal Facilities for Hazardous Waste, Bio-medical Waste and e-waste, the Central Government can provide financial assistance up to 25% of the total cost for setting up an Integrated E-waste recycling facility on Public Private Partnership basis, subject to matching contribution by the State Government. The maximum limit of Central subsidy would be Rs. 12.5 crores.
