- (a) the status of the implementation of projects/proposals to widen Highways from Patna-purnia, Patna-Buxar and Patna-Bodh Gaya into four lanes;
- (b) whether there is any proposal to widen Chhapra-Gopalganj Highway into four lane;
- (c) if so, the time since when the said work is lying pending; and
- (d) the reasons for delay in starting the work?

- (a) The status of implementation of projects/proposals to widen Highways from Patna-purnia, Patna-Buxar and Patna-Bodh Gaya into four lanes is annexed.
- (b) There is a proposal to develop the Gopalganj Chapra section of NH 85 in two lanes with paved shoulders on BOT(Annuity) basis.
- (c) & (d) No response was received to invitation of bids for four laning of this stretch on BOT(Toll) basis. The project was restructured for 2-lane with paved shoulder on BOT(Toll) basis and bids were re-invited. No bids were received till the bid due date of 16.04.2010. Bids for 2-laning of Gopalganj-Chhapra section has been re-invited. The due date for submission of bids is 10.01.2010.
